Program

The baccalaureate program of Hope College of Arts and Sciences prepares a nurse generalist for practice that integrates the knowledge, skills and attitudes of seven curricular elements: liberal education, quality care and patients safety, evidence-based practice, healthcare policy, finance, and regulatory environments, communication and collaboration, clinical prevention, population health, professionalism and professional values.

The program is designed to provide an educational framework, based on the principle of life-long learning, whereby students develop a broad knowledge base enabling them to read analytically, communicate clearly, and think critically in order to problem-solve. The faculty is committed to the promotion of students success from admission through graduation. Through the nursing, students will utilize their learned skills of prevention, therapeutic intervention and rehabilitation, as well as promotion and maintenance of optimal health in order to meet the health needs of the community they serve in a safe and competent manner.
